

Findon Sheep Fair - Saturday 14th September 2024 - Details

Sheep Judging Details: -

Entry cost, per farm: £8:00 per pen (without straw)
 £2:00 per fleece (no charge, if also entering sheep)

Pens will be labelled with a number and flock or farm name and we will be happy for you to add your own descriptive material to the sides of the pens as usual.

Sheep are eligible to enter sections as shown below according to their breeds.

Other Rare and Native Breeds, as defined by the RBST, but not listed below may be entered into an appropriate section subject to prior agreement with the Judges.

Entries for the "group of three" class must all be of the same breed, consist of 2 of one sex and one of the other and have all been shown in individual classes earlier in the day.

In those sections for which there is a separate Shearling Ewe class, entries to the Ewe class must have borne a lamb during the current calendar year.

For the Fleece section fleeces should be rolled and labelled with the class and owners name. If you wish us to sell the fleece after the judging please indicate a price on the back of the label.

There will be trophies in certain sections and classes, as shown below, together with money prizes and rosettes for all classes and sections.

Judging times and parking details (arrival by 9:15 latest) will be sent to you after entry.
Judges decision is final.
